The Tunnell Trust for Young Musicians was established following the merger of the John Tunnell Trust and the Young Musicians' Trust in 1999

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The John Tunnell Trust was formed in 1988 by family members, colleagues and friends of the late John Tunnell, OBE, the founder leader of the Scottish Chamber Orchestra. The Trust was established in order to support young musicians and chamber groups in particular. The aim of all the Trust's work is to help to bridge the difficult gap between the student and professional worlds for its young musicians, where recognition and experience can only be gained from quality performing opportunities.

In 1993 Wendy, John's widow, set up the Young Musicians' Trust wishing to do even more to promote young musicians. She ran the Trust until her untimely death in 1998. The Young Musicians' Trust promoted its own series of concerts in country houses, schools and other venues and staged an annual study and performance week at Strathgarry in Perthshire, Scotland. It won extraordinary support from many high profile sponsors.

The Trust's Awards Scheme has assisted some 131 young chamber music ensembles (496 individual musicians) and 87 different Scottish Music Clubs in 794 concerts. The Trust pays the fees of outstanding young groups to play at Music Clubs all over Scotland with an emphasis on helping Clubs in small and remote places as well as in the major centres. Young groups are selected annually at auditions held in London.

In addition the Trust promotes its own annual summer study & performance week on the Isle of Coll in the Inner Hebrides - *Music Coll*. This ten day event gives up to five young groups the chance to work together for an intensive period of time without distraction. There is time to rehearse, receive inspiring tuition and to perform in our three public recitals. The Trust has enjoyed outstanding success. It has been able to provide much needed learning and performing opportunities for young musicians at the outset of their careers, as well as vital support for local arts and educational organisations often situated within isolated communities. As a working Trust, there is a need to raise funds annually in support of the Awards Scheme which enters its 35th season. After a highly successful move to the Isle of Coll eleven years ago, the Trust's study and performance week is also a focal point for much needed fundraising. The Course now enters its 31st year. Much of the Trust's work is generously funded by large national charities, commercial sponsors and many individuals

The Trust is under the Artistic Directorship of John and Wendy's eldest son, Jonathan, a professional cellist.

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Introduction from the Artistic Director

I am delighted to present the Annual Review of activities for our 2023/24 season.

Our <u>Music Club Awards Scheme</u> auditions for 2023 took place in September. 15 chamber ensembles were chosen for audition following applications from a record number of 52 groups. We chose to award 22 concerts to a total of four fabulous groups for the 2024/2025 season. A full list of forthcoming concerts can be seen on the next page.

The <u>Music Club Awards Scheme</u> concerts in the 2023/2024 season, given by our 2022 winners, were a huge success. Reviews from these concerts can be found on our website.

We were delighted to host our eleventh <u>Music Coll</u> study & performance week in June/July 2024. We welcomed 13 young musicians in three chamber groups to Coll last summer. They played to much bigger audiences than in the previous year: numbers were up by 20% from 2023.

Fundraising in 2023/24 saw 11 of our more regular funders continuing to support our young musicians generously as well as two new charities offering grants during the year.

For the <u>Music Club Awards Scheme</u> we are very grateful to have received grants from the CMS Charitable Trust, Cruden Foundation, Albert & Eugenie Frost Music Trust, Hugh Fraser Foundation, Hope Scott Trust, Cookie Matheson Charitable Trust, Radcliffe Trust, N Smith Charitable Settlement, Bernard Sunley Charitable Foundation and the Marigold Whittome Memorial Trust.

Our 2024 Auditions for the <u>Music Club Awards Scheme</u> took place on 12th September in London. We chose to award 21 concerts to five groups for the 2025/2026 season: <u>Chloé Piano Trio, Hyde Clarinet Quartet, Intesa Duo, Talos Quartet</u> and <u>Trio Archai</u>. We look forward to another year of outstanding music making from all our young musicians in 2025.

During **Music Coll 2024** we held 3 public recitals with an increase in audience numbers of 20% from the previous year. Throughout the week we were lucky to enjoy superb facilities at the community centre An Cridhe. The hall's acoustics are perfect for chamber music and the accommodation facilities in the adjacent Bunk House proved ideal for everyone. Our team of local chefs provided superb home-cooked sustenance for everyone during the event.

As ever, the incredible support from so many local people helped to ensure that the event ran extremely smoothly.

The Financial Year

The Trust's spending on charitable activities for young musicians amounted to £48,544 (2023 - £54,686).

The Income of the Trust during the year was £52,346 (2023 - £47,302).

The Trust's main investments consist of fixed interest British Government Stocks and other Equities, managed on the advice of its Brokers.

Net assets at the end of the year were £354,674 (2023 - £332,695).
